We have an exciting half term ahead. Here is an overview of the topics that we will be covering in Year 2/3:

<u>Subject</u>	Topic	
English writing – Everyday	Our English lessons this half term are based around the books 'The Minpins' by Roald Dahl and Patrick Benson and 'Flatsam' by David Wiesner. During the sequence, children will create their own adventure narrative, postcards and a mystery narrative.	
Spelling	 Year 2 The suffixes -ment, -ness and -ful. The suffixes -less and -ly. Words ending in -tion. Contractions. Possessive apostrophes. Common exception words. 	 Year 3 Words ending in –ary. Words with a short /u/ sound spelt with 'ou' Word families based on common words, showing how words are related in form and meaning.
Maths – Everyday	 Year 2 Mass, capacity and temperature. Fractions. Time. 	 Year 3 Mass and capacity. Fractions. Money. Time.
Science - Thursday History-	In Science this half term we will be looking at seeds and bulbs and the conditions they need in order to grow. We will be looking at how these change over time through working scientifically. We will also be looking at different food groups and their functions. We will be looking at Ancient Egyptian this half term. We will be looking at the river Nile,	
Tuesday Music – Friday	Tutankhamun, hieroglyphics and Gods and Goddesses.This half term we will be doing drumba and we will be learning to play recorders.	
PE – Monday and Wednesday.	We will be doing swimming and athletics on alternative Mondays. Wednesday will be work out Wednesday.	
Computing– Tuesday	In our first E-Safety unit, we will be learning about online behaviour expectations. We will then be using code.org to develop our programming skills.	
Art- Thursday	This term we will be using clay to create a cartouche linked to our Egyptian topic.	
RE – Monday	Our key question in RE this term is 'what kind of world did Jesus want?'	
RSHE – Wednesday	In RSHE we will be looking at family relationships, looking at different roles and responsibilities within a family.	
French – Friday	This term we will be learning how to say the days of the week and months of the year.
