Trip to New Walk Museum and Art Gallery, Leicester, Monday 7 December

As part of our topic this term, we have arranged for Year 4 to spend the day at the New Walk Museum and Art Gallery in Leicester. In addition to looking at the collection of Egyptian artefacts on display, we will be able to handle a variety of artefacts, use replicas to complete a task, make amulets, dress like an Egyptian and generally learn more about mummies!

Children will need to be in school at the usual time, in full uniform, complete with coat, packed lunch and a drink of water. Lunches should be in disposable packaging, please. There is a small shop at the museum, for postcards etc. (but no sweets!) so children may bring a maximum of £2 with them in a labeled purse/envelope. We will return in time for the end of the school day, so collection will be as usual from the school. Travel will be by coach both ways; if your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they have the necessary medicines before the journey and any other medicines labeled and given to myself at the beginning of the day.
