You only need to select sounds from the first 2-3 lines. https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/odd-and-bob?phase=5 if they are finding it too tricky try phase 4 https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/odd-and-bob?phase=4 select cvcc plus digraphs</p> <p>if you do not have access to a device you can print off a phase 5 sound mat from the files on the class web page</p>	<p>Number bonds Using 10 and 20 counters (pasta shapes / pebbles / counters) practise calculating which numbers go together to make 10 / 20.</p> <p>If $2 + 8 = 10$, then $2 + 18 = 20$ If $3 + 7 = 10$, then $3 + 17 = 20$ If $5 + 5 = 10$, then $5 + 15 = 20$</p> <p>Can they see the pattern? Complete Find and make number bonds sheet. Use objects for counting to support if required. (Questions start easier and get more challenging – work through to the level your child can manage)</p> <p>Extra practise – say number (eg. 7) child shouts 3. Repeat numbers to 10</p>	<p>Think about someone who is special to you, what makes them special? Can you draw a picture of them and add some sentences to say why they are special.</p> <p>Make sure you form the whole sentence verbally before you start writing. Your sentences should have capital letters and full stops and spaces between the words.</p> <p>Try to add some conjunctions to your sentences. (eg. And, because)</p> <p>I've included a support sheet in the files to support this.</p>	<p>We are all different Venn diagram worksheet. (saved in files)</p> <p>Look at the different activities, and work with someone else at home, what do you like that they don't, what do you both like? Follow the instructions at the top of the first page.</p>

Start with your home, then your village, your town, your country, your continent then your planet.
