Yellow House enjoyed their treat this week with a play outside and an ice lolly.



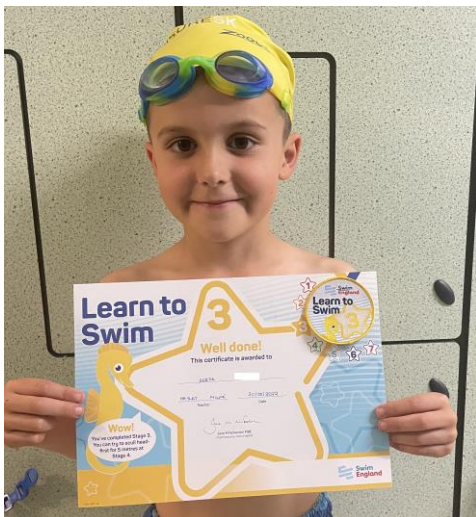
## Out of School Achievements

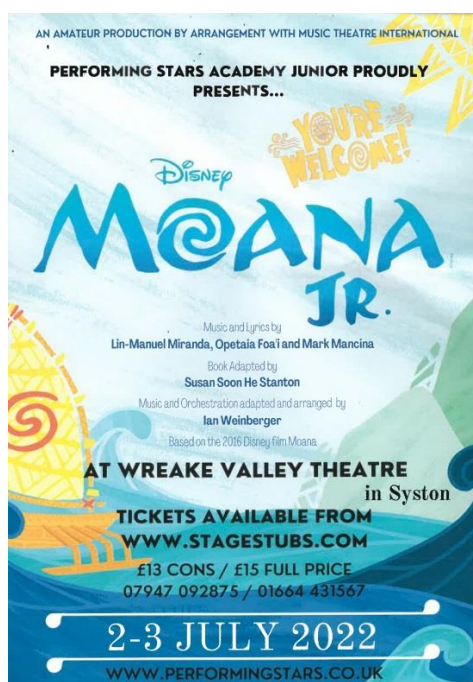
