Thank you and well done to all of the children and parents who took part in our Walk to School week.

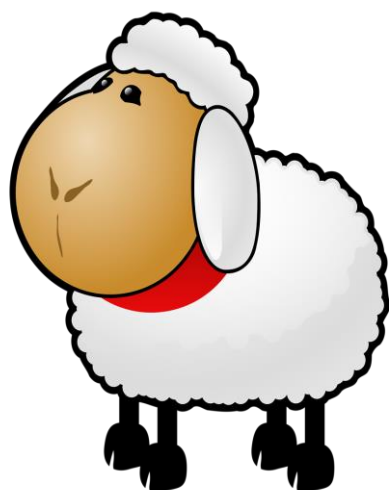
It was fantastic to see everybody getting involved and coming together to make the arrival at School a more healthy and active experience.
