These will start week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> October and run until the week ending 6<sup>th</sup> December.

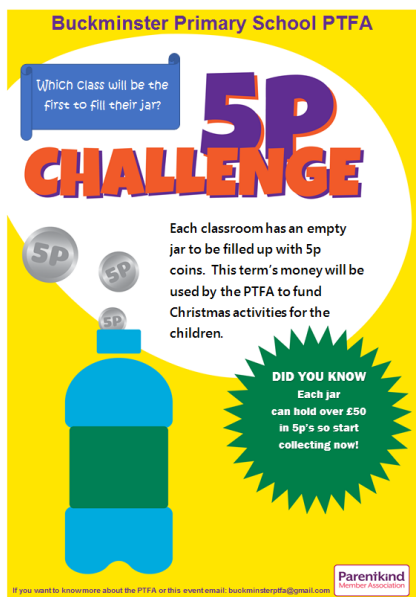

## FREE CLASSES - LAUNCH WEEK TIMETABLE 16-17<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2019

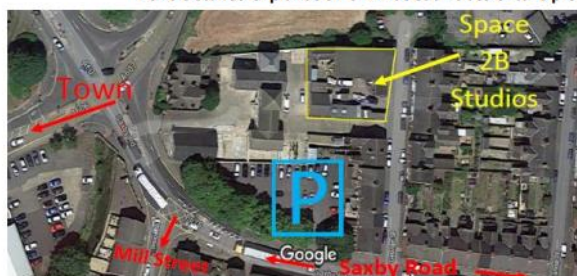
