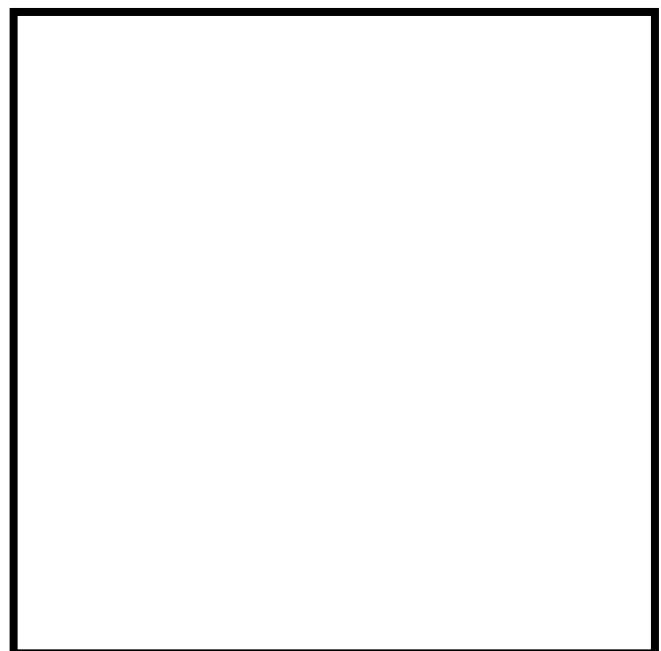

The cat went home and told Domingo that he was to marry the daughter of the king. But Domingo had nothing to wear. So the cat went to the king and told him that his master lost

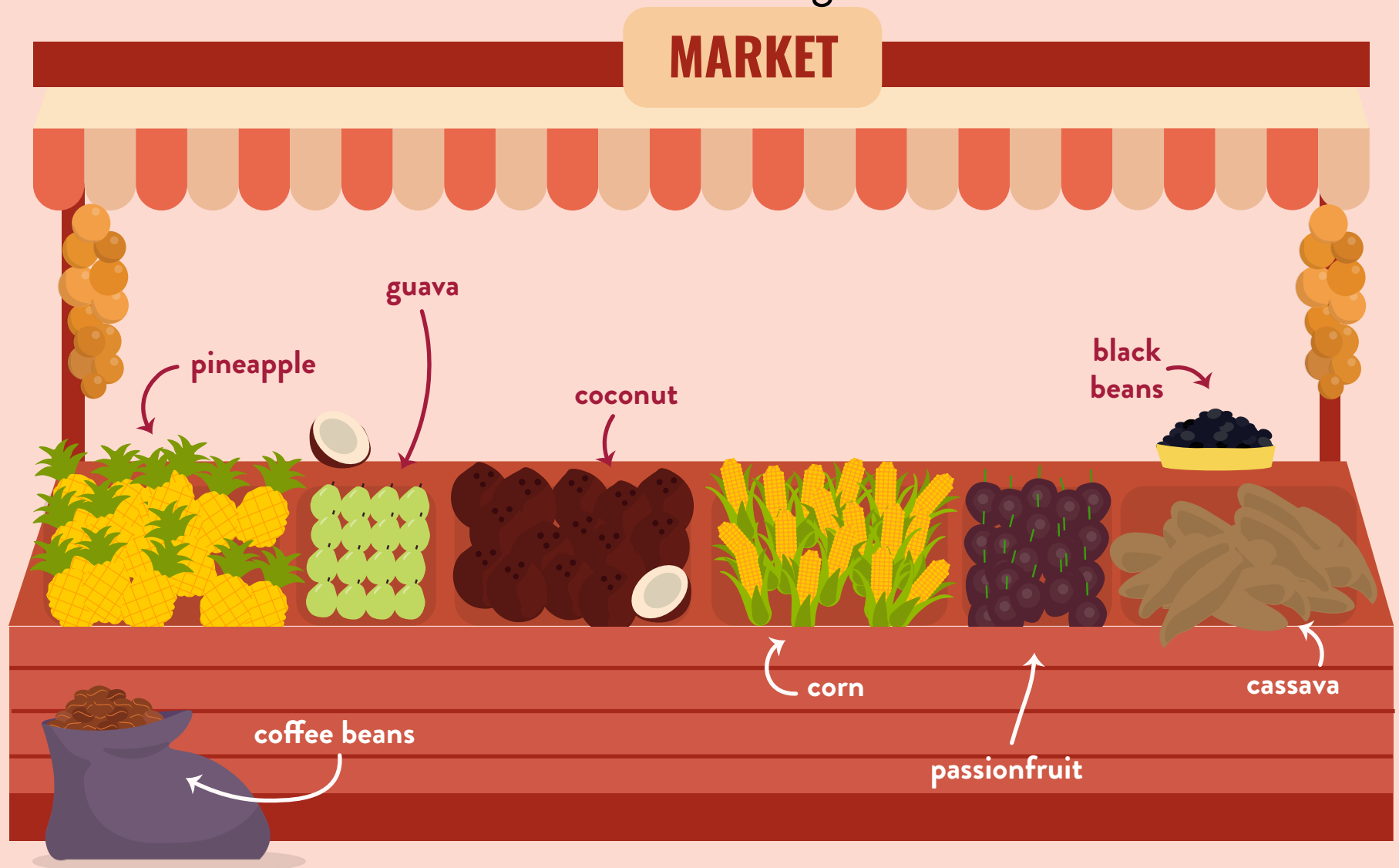
all his wedding clothes in a fire. The king sent the most beautiful garments and Domingo could dress up for the wedding.

3. Which fruit is above the coffee beans and next to the guava? -----

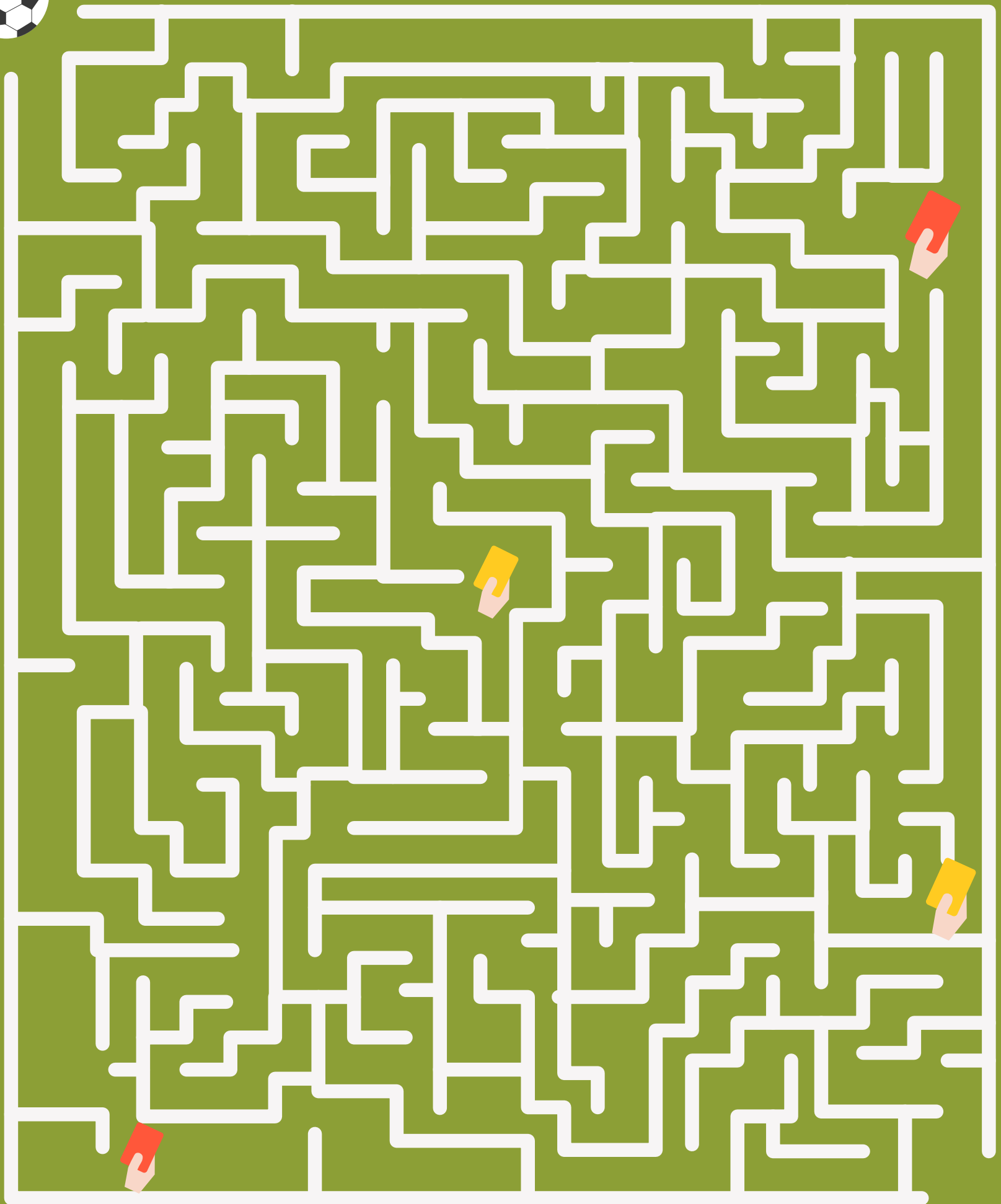


7. Brazilian Football Maze
