1	<p>What is meant by the term cohesion in writing?</p> <p>Cohesion in writing means that paragraphs are well structured, logical and flow smoothly. Ideas link together within and across paragraphs. Award the mark if the gist is clear.</p>	1 mark
2	<p>Why is cohesion important?</p> <p><i>Award up to 3 marks for each point made.</i></p> <p>It keeps order in the paragraphs.</p> <p>Related ideas are kept together.</p> <p>Makes it easier for the reader to understand the text.</p> <p>Ideas flow more smoothly.</p> <p>Provides links between ideas.</p>	3 mark
3	<p>What are cohesive devices?</p> <p>Cohesive devices are strategies used to create cohesion in a text, e.g. adverbials, repetition of a word or phrase, ellipsis.</p>	1 mark
4	<p>Can you make a list of five different ways to create cohesion across paragraphs?</p> <p><i>Award up to 5 marks; 1 for each cohesive device given.</i></p> <p>adverbials – time, place, number, cause and effect, clarification, exception, contrast /compare, emphasis /addition</p> <p>repetition of words/phrases</p> <p>ellipsis</p> <p>logical order of paragraphs/ideas within paragraphs</p> <p>information is clear /relevant</p>	5 mark
