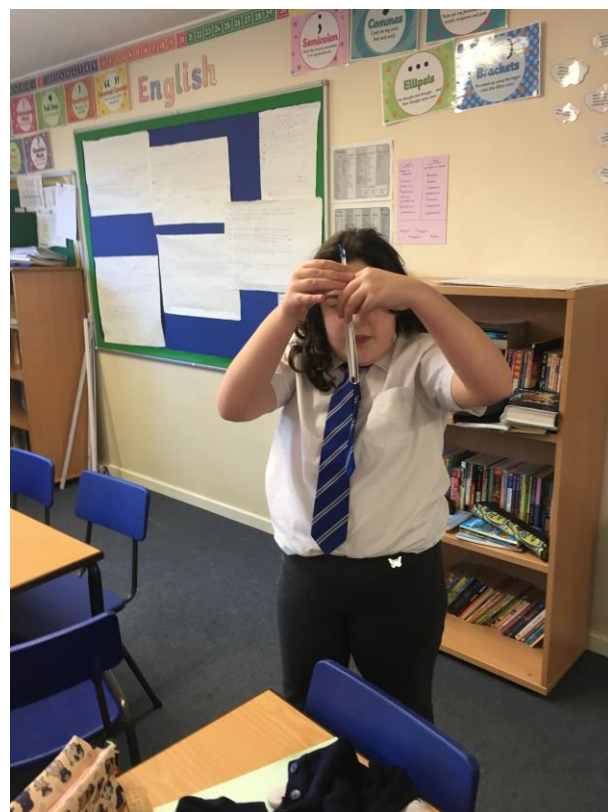
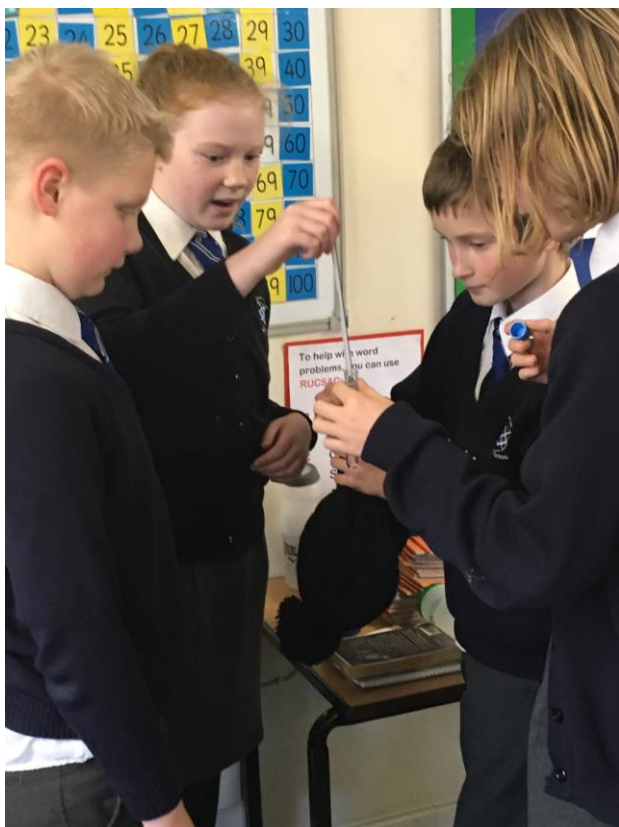


Class topics for this term
