

Times Tables.

The national curriculum expectations for times tables knowledge are set out below. Remember this is the expectation for the **end and not the start** of the school year. So a child entering Year 3 should know their 2s, 5s, and 10s. By the end of year 4 they are expected to know all 12 tables.

Expectations for times tables for each year group:	
Year 1	Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Recall and use all doubles to 10 and corresponding halves.
Year 2	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
Year 3	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
Year 4	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12.
