Inspire+

As many of you are aware, Inspire+ is a sports charity we work closely with and have done for the past two years. They provide exciting sporting and wellbeing opportunities for all children as well as training for staff. Last year we utilised specialist coaches for gymnastics, core skills PE and we had the fantastic Sophie Allen run a Boot Camp in the summer term. We have had visits from inspirational sports men and women, ex Olympians and Paralympians including Sam Ruddock and England hockey star Shona McCallin. This year we will be receiving 10 Balance Bikes and training for our Early Years children, a dance specialist for year 3/4 for a term, a multi skills coach for Yr5/6 for the year, a gifted and talented programme and much more.

This charity is funded through the government's sports funding scheme with each school receiving £16,000. A large proportion of our funding goes towards paying for the wonderful services of Inspire+ but, like all government initiatives, it might not last forever! Schools are not sure whether funding will continue for one more year or 4 years so, along with many other schools in the area, we are keen to support the charity and its sustainability.

Inspire+ are already planning for this gap in funding to ensure they can continue to provide support, not only for the children at our school today but for those yet to join us. One of their plans is to maximise the SKLottery opportunity being run by South Kesteven District Council. It is a weekly lottery with a jack pot of £25,000. Tickets are just £1 and 50p from each ticket goes to the buyers nominated charity (Inspire+). If every school were able to influence £100 tickets being sold weekly (e.g. this could be 20p parents paying £5 a week) this would bring in £104,000 back into schools via Inspire+.
