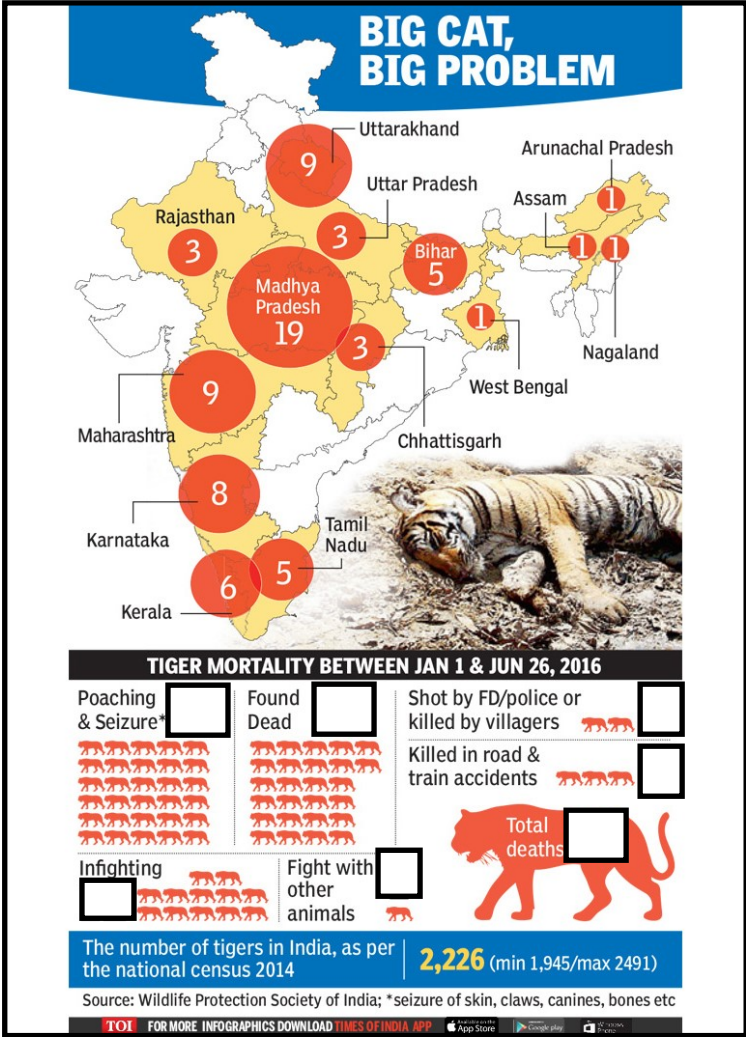


Tiger Maths Problems.

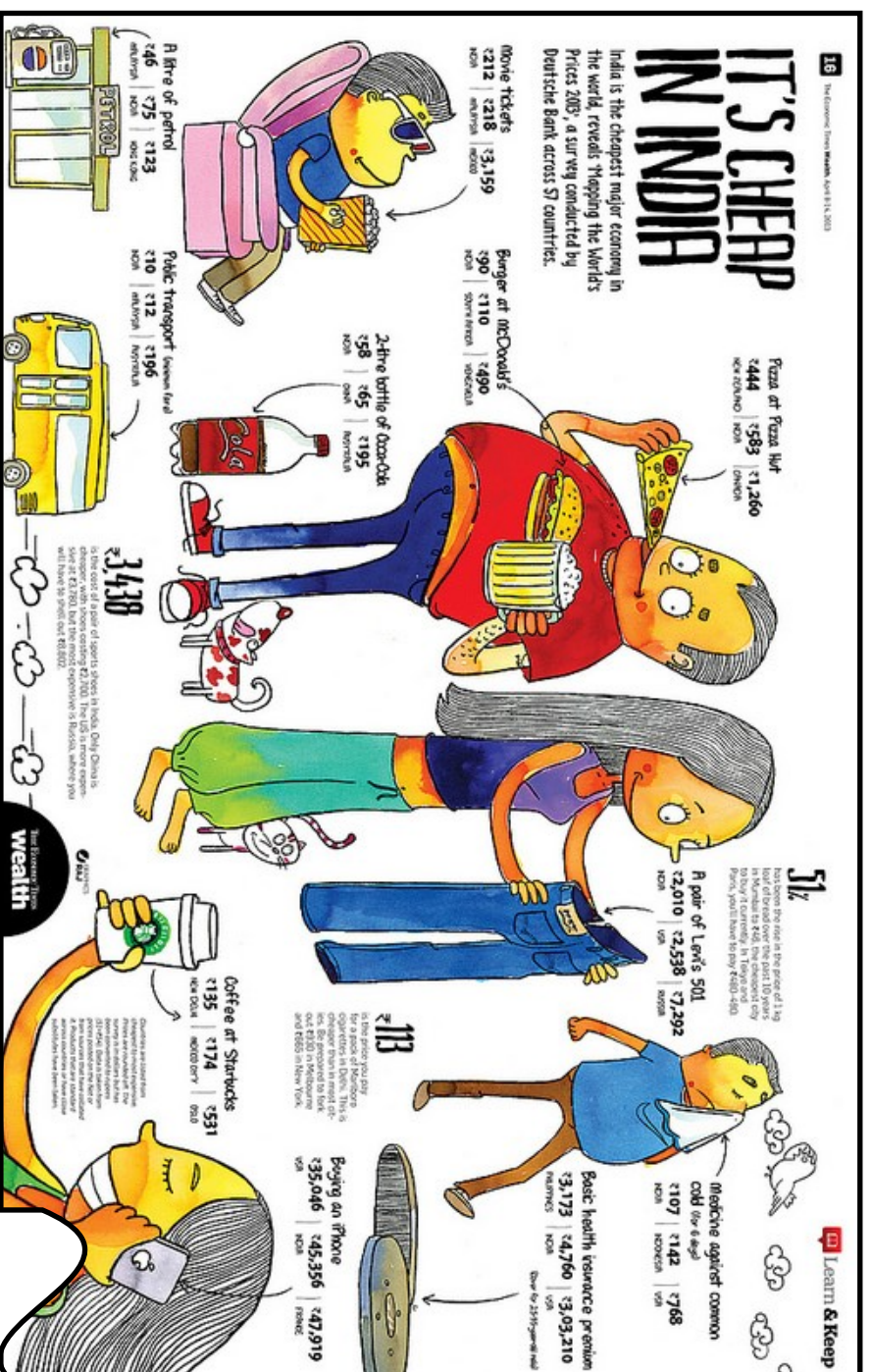
